



Hannah More School Fact Sheet

Hannah More School is a nonpublic day school for students with disabilities, including emotional disturbance, autism, specific learning disabilities or health impairments. The school provides individualized academic, vocational and therapeutic programs to middle and high school students (grades 6 – 12), whose behaviors have hindered their ability to be successful in public school.

Established: 1978

Enrollment: Approximately 115 students (Reisterstown), 47 (Type II Schools)

Campus Locations: Reisterstown, Md.; Severna Park, Md.; Severn, Md.; Millersville, Md.; and Hampstead, Md.

Academic Programs:

- Middle school
- High school – Included within the traditional high school curriculum is the Decker Career Technology Education Program, which includes courses in automotive, horticulture and landscaping, culinary arts, information and communications, and building trades/construction.

Type II Schools: Collaborative program between Hannah More School and local school system; provides a “school within a school” for students who may need special services provided by Hannah More School staff but can be mainstreamed into the public school for part of the day.

- Anne Arundel County
 - Hannah More at Severna Park High School
 - Hannah More at Severn River Middle School
 - Hannah More at Millersville Elementary School
- Carroll County
 - Hannah More at North Carroll High School

Clinical Programs: Comprehensive therapeutic services for each student, including individual and group therapies with social workers, psychologist, and expressive therapists. Psychiatric services available as needed.

Students:

- Diagnosed with either emotional disabilities or autism spectrum conditions
- Reside throughout the greater Baltimore metropolitan area
- Referred by their local public schools (tuition is paid by local school system and the state)
- Earn a high school diploma or certificate of completion
- Meet the graduation requirements required by their local public school system

Faculty/Staff: All faculty/staff meet the certification/licensure requirements mandated for public school teachers.

- Student-faculty ratio: 9:2
- Number of faculty/staff, including full time and part time:
 - *Reisterstown* – 123; 10 part time, 113 full time
 - *Anne Arundel* – 16; 1 part time 15 full time
 - *Carroll* – 5; all full time

Average class size: 7
